Details & Rules of Ladies Night: Camping Edition at Myrtle Beach State Park - March 25-26, 2017, 1:00pm-11:30am

***Registration Deadline:** Saturday, March 18, 2017 at 4:00pm

***Age Limit:** 13 and up (parent or legal guardian must attend with anyone under 18)

***Price:** \$50 per person (free entrance into the park)

***Purpose:** To facilitate a supported camping experience for women only.

***Sleeping Arrangements:** Participants will be sleeping in tents at the overflow campground, which lacks electricity. A standard comfort station with hot showers is available to participants during the event. If you have your own tent, you are strongly encouraged to bring it. However, a limited number of tents are available to share with participants at the event, although those tents may not accommodate personal air mattresses.

***Restroom Facilities:** Standard comfort station with lights, hot water, and hot showers.

***Provided Snacks:** Food and snacks will be provided. Special dietary needs cannot be accommodated at this event. Therefore, bring additional food, snacks, and drinks to the event to be comfortable. Alcohol is prohibited at all South Carolina State Parks.

The menu is as follows:

Saturday Afternoon: Trail Mix

Saturday Night: Foil dinners, s'mores

Sunday Morning: Hot water, boiled bag omelets with biscuits and cinnamon rolls

***Smoking Policy:** Participants will not be allowed to smoke in the overflow campground, near the bathroom, where people are sleeping, or attending a program. All cigarette butts must be disposed of in the dumpster.

***Park Entrance Combo:** Participants will be provided with the park gate combo for the night. For safety reasons, participants are required to sign out if they leave in the middle of the night.

***Things to NOT Bring:** Electronic Devices that make noise (games, computers, radio, etc.) No electricity is available for you to charge your devices.

***Litter:** Make sure all food and toiletries are secured at all times to avoid attracting wildlife. We have recycling stations and a dumpster located in the overflow campground. Cigarette butts are litter and should be placed in the dumpster, not thrown on the ground.

***Other Personal Items To Bring**

Clothing appropriate for the weather

Appropriate sleeping attire

Closed-toed shoes

Sleeping bag/bedding (pillow)

Camping/Folding chair

Flashlight/headlamp/lantern (must be battery-operated)

Extra Batteries

Personal toiletries (toothbrush, soap, etc.)

Linens (hand towel, body towel, etc.)

Reusable Dishes (Water/Coffee Cup, Plate, Cloth Napkin, Bowl Fork/Spoon/Knife)

Bug Spray

***Optional Items**

Tent and ground cover (we encourage you to bring your own tent if you have one)

Air mattress or sleeping pad (if desired, but air mattresses may not be accommodated by our tents; pump provided)

Powdered drink mixes and/or flavored drops. Only water is provided.

Sunscreen

Instant coffee/tea/hot cocoa (hot water provided)

We encourage you to disconnect from your electronics, but if you need to charge your cell phone, you will need to bring a portable power bank or car charger as electricity is not available in the overflow campground.
