







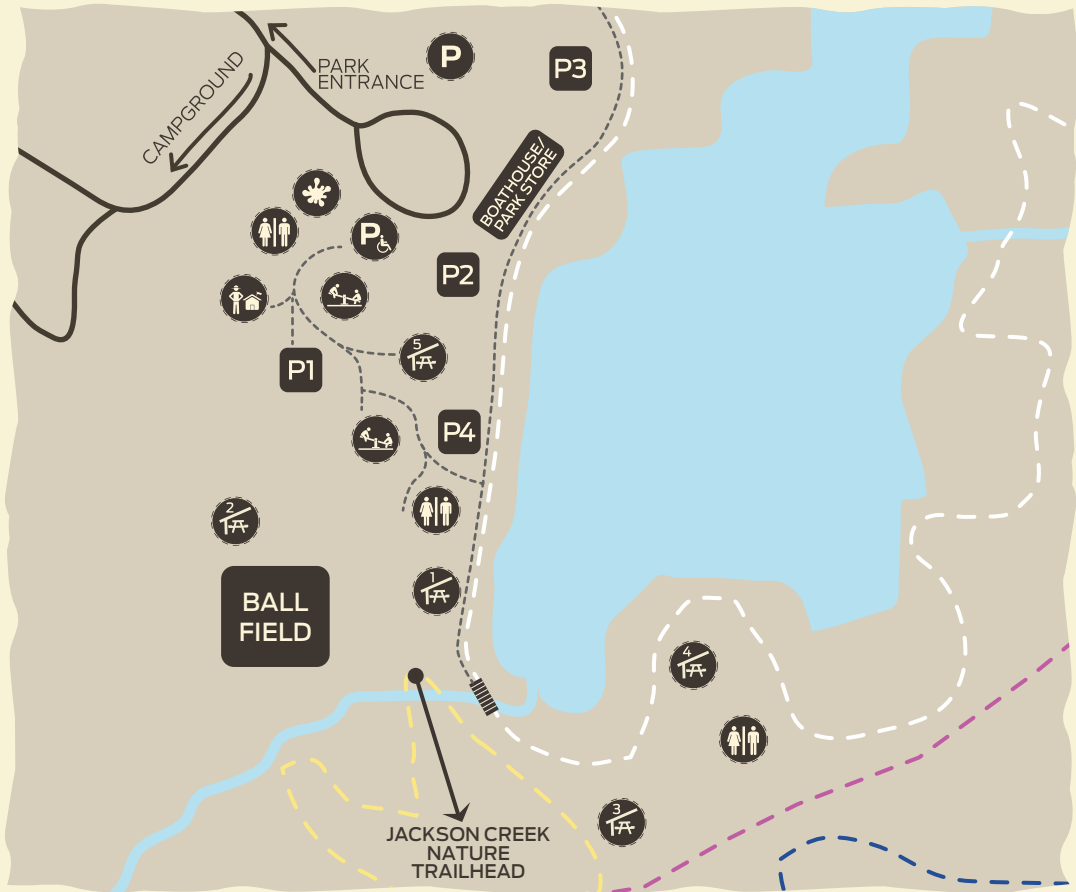

### DAILY ADMISSION

Adults (age 16-64 years)	\$5.00 per person
SC resident seniors (age 65 & up), 100% disabled and active duty SC National Guard	\$3.25 per person
Children (age 6 - 15)	\$3.00
Children 5 and under	FREE

### Park Hours

8 a.m. – 6 p.m., daily (extended hours during DST)

### PARK ACTIVITIES INCLUDE:


Fishing, trails (hiking/biking/walking), ball field, sand volleyball, playgrounds, seasonal boat rentals, interpretive programs, splash pad and a DNR tackle loaner program (need a pole? Just ask a ranger). Also, a variety of balls and games can be checked out of the park office for no charge.


Please familiarize yourself with the policies and adhere to signs posted throughout the park.

- All guests are required to pay park admission in addition to any facility rental.
- All alcohol is prohibited on state park property.
- For parties of 150 people or more, one-month advance notice is required.
- Please contact the park office for approval for all activities not offered by Sesquicentennial.
  - A Special Use Permit may be required (\$25 non-refundable fee).
  - Please allow 3 months' notice for permit processing.
- Balloons, piñatas, confetti, rice or streamers are not allowed as they can be harmful to our animals.
  - Natural alternatives you can use are flowers, birdseed and bubbles.
- Barbecue grills are allowed.
  - Approval is required for tents, tables, chairs, etc.
  - Please, no drop cords or generators.
- Shelter and picnic pad rentals are for the day. Come during park hours for setup if needed.
  - Please be advised, we do not offer rain checks.
- Music should be kept to a level not to be heard outside of your immediate area.
- Seasonal boat rentals 9 a.m. – 4 p.m. daily (canoes, kayaks, paddleboards, fishing and pedal boats).
  - For safety reasons, all boats should be off the water and returned by 5 p.m.
